To the International Water Institute, Solar Irrigation for Agricultural Resilience Fund:

I am writing to recommend the project proposed by the non-profit Association for Welfare Activities and Rural Education (A.W.A.R.E.) of Tamil Nadu, India, for Solar Irrigation for 500 rural families in Ramanathapuram District, Kadaladi Block. The director, Mr. U. Boopathy, has been known to me for over 15 years. I have supported A.W.A.R.E each year with donations to help with disaster relief activities, poverty reduction, women's welfare and their children's rural education, including that of HIV+ Positive children. I have also sent trainees from Japan for internships at A.W.A.R.E., where they were welcomed and enabled to participate in every aspect of the association's activities.

My field is sustainable development in Asia and I have worked mainly in Southeast and East Asian rural communities, identifying threats to food-producing land and water.

From this standpoint I strongly recommend AWARE's proposal for a 2-year project on Solar Irrigation for Agricultural Resilience. This project, which seeks to provide the means for better agricultural outputs in the very dry, very poor Kadiladisubdistrict, has the potential to mitigate the effects of worsening climate and dry, clay soil at a lower cost and more sustainably.

The entire area, which is coastal and rural, is dependent on agriculture for 70% of its income despite its climate being semi-arid with frequently occurring droughts. The current agricultural situation obviously means a food gap in a community where extreme poverty already hampers access to basic needs. The Kadiladi block (subdistrict) of the Ramanathapuram District ranks in the bottom 2 out of 11 subdistricts in its Human Development Index. It ranks in the bottom 3 in the Child Development Index and is the lowestranked in the Multidimensional Poverty Index. Women and children perform most of the agricultural labor while men have usually migrated internally to find day labor. The arrival of COVID-19 has made an unfortunate situation worse, as men cannot easily find town-based jobs and more children have dropped out of school.

Photovoltaic pumps to access groundwater are at this point one of the most sustainable ways to mitigate drought and low precipitation in an area without other financial means to subsist. By reducing the cost burden of energy inputs the POV pumps will allow the Kadiladicultivators to produce food and some income without the burden of added debt. Further, the project can prove to be a model for similar communities. The proposed implementation period of 2 years is feasible, with the earliest-built POV equipment and water tanks to servein confirming or enhancing the functioning of those units being built throughout the period.

It is with great pleasure that I highly recommend this tirelessly working, human-focussed Association's proposal for solar irrigation for 500 households in Kadiladi of Ramanathapuram District, Tamil Nadu.


