Work shop and seminar on DOWRI Legal awareness to women members on 21.07. 2018

Dowry the bridal price demanded by the bridegroom's family at the time of marriage and even after marriage -though prohibited by law- is still widely prevalent among all irrespective of caste religion and economic background. Ultimately the girls at lower helm of the economic fabric are the ultimate sufferers. Many a girls are not able to get married at the right age and if they get married they have to pay dearly at the time of marriage and after marriage. There are instances of death of the girls suicide or death by unknown reasons due to dowry harassment by the in-laws and husbands. Only few cases are recorded and are in the public domain while many such cases go unnoticed and unrecorded. As dowry has become deeply rooted in the cultural milieu of the communities in India, this can only be eradicated through proper education of the girls and consistent training and sensitization of women.

For this AWARE continuously strives to provide the needed support to the women members of the network by way of training them on the issues confronting them through the dowry menace and the ways and means to prevent and protect them from such mishap. Two trainings of two days duration each were organized in batches of 30 each for the women members and during the training need for education of girls and the significance economic empowerment which will free them from the shackles of poverty and enable their social mobility were intensely discussed. The legal aspects of the dowry act were explained to them and the point that dowry in no way is a prerequisite for a comfortable marriage but when a female is educated she becomes a torch bearer for a whole generation that follows. These were stressed upon through interesting interactive sessions and simulation exercises. Experts in the field will guide the proceedings. Mrs. Gangavithya and Mrs. Tamiselvi BA.BL--advocates were the resource persons who guided the proceedings on the two trainings. These trainings were organized on 22.07.2018 and 23.07.2018 respectively.

The AWARE Team workers with volunteers would conducted the survey based on various parameters including physical condition, family history and life style of those surveyor AWARE appealed to the people to extend their full cooperation to the exercise. 52 expectant mothers mostly the newly married and first time mothers were invited to the training program as those mothers found the program beneficial and relevant to them and their present situation. The expectant mothers found the program beneficial to them in learning how to keep them and their health balanced, stronger, taking adequate and nutritious food , keep their health and hygiene intact, do's & don'ts during pregnancies, safe abortion, safe motherhood safe delivery, and safe childhood and regular check up from the first period stops to the birth of the child regularly with one woman doctor specialized in obstetrics and gynecology, The training has been organized twice, 2 days each. In view of creating sustainable livelihood for the rural and urban dalit women, widow and deserted women widow and deserted women, AWARE conducted 3 days entrepreneurship development training. According by such 47 women have been trained and disbursed micro finance to coverace mini dairy, goat rearing, mini tiffen stall vgetable and furit vending by hard cart. Each women earns Rs.90/- per day. AWARE conducted Dairy Management Training and Goat Management Training.

During the reporting period, AWARE conducted a series of short term training on embroidery designing, Incense stick making, pickle making, masala powder making, (Chilly and coriander powder) etc., After completion training programme, the selected women beneficiaries from urban slums and rural areas were given equipment and micro finance to involve in production amount on collective basis or individual 43 urban women and 33 rural women, totally 77 women benefited directly and 308 benefited indirectly.

Training and Rehabilitation Scheme for HIV Positive Women and WIPs:

Under the HIV / AIDS Prevention Programme. AWARE has identified HIV positive women and women in prostitution (WIPs) in slum areas located in Trichy City Corporation. Accordingly, a three month Tailoring Training and a two month Greetings Cards Training are imparted to the women by AWARE. During the last year, tailoring machines were given To 3 HIV Positive women and 4 WIPs after completion of the Training programme. Further, a ten day training was given on Animal Husbandry with the help the help of Tamil Nadu Animal Husbandry and Veterinary University, Trichy. The WIPs are promoted in to women Self Help Groups in Oothukkuli and Kulalampatti villages of Manikandan block. The SHGs women are helped to avail loan through the linkages of Nationalized Bank and PACBs to commence Mini Dairy unit on their own. This rehabilitation measures; has enabled the women to generate A supportive income for their families.

Social Empowerment still eludes women

Women had a long way to go to get social empowerment despite getting access to education, said Former Trichy city Mayor SaruBala R.Thondaiman here on Thursday 16.03.2017. Releasing a Booklet on Menstrual hygiene management at valediction of 10 day training programme in Tailoring and Dress making organized by AWARE trust Trichy and Indian Medical Association, Trichy, she said that there were many avenues for providing basic and higher education to Girls. There was a good awareness among people on educating women. Similarly, a section of women had attained economic empowerment to an extent. On political empowerment, Ms.Thondaiman said that the recent state Government law on providing 50% reservation for women in local bodies by the late chief Minister Jayalalitha had paved the way for about 1.25 lakh women in the state to corporation, Municipalities, town panchayates and others. However, the women had not social empowerment as several women continued to be at the receiving end due to indiscrimination, abuse, sexual harassment and others.

B.Rajeswari WDP Director AWARE said there was a strong need to create awareness among women of all section of the society including rural, urban, housewife and office goers on menstrual and hygiene management. It would add value to the ongoing Swachh Bharat Mission.

R.A.Krishnakumar Executive Director, Dalmia cements Ltd said the AWARE had made a good beginning by providing vocational training to women within a short span. U.Boopathy Executive Director of AWARE, D.Uma secretary of AWARE, V.Rani, Ramalaxmi spoke.

The young Girls AWARE call helps block 10 Child marriages

Young girls timely action has helped child line volunteers swing into action to prevent 10 child marriages in the Appadurai village panchayat in the trichy district of Tamilnadu. Acting on a tip-off from the girl, the volunteers swooped down on the village panchayat and found that 10 school going girls were to be married off during the summer vacation.

I wish to study, It was a distress call from one of the girls to child line's toll-free number – 1098 – which led to the identification of the 10 arranged marriages “I wish to study kindly do something to save me from the marriage my parents have arranged for me the girl cried on the phone.

The child line and AWARE team comprising with co-coordinator B.Rajeswari MSW, and counselors Mr.Raju and Volunteer Mr.Karunamoorthi was quick to respond. Investigation led to nine other similar cases in Allidurai and Enammathur in panchayat.

The marriage of some of the girls was fixed some months ago. Some of them had begun interacting with their phone. All of them belonged to poor families and their parents were making a living through daily labour.

The AWARE and child line team contacted the ward member and the child development project officer who acts as the child marriage prevention officer in the area. Ward councilor Mrs.Lakshmi had reportedly ignored the child line alert.

'She said she was not interested in the case, and that she had more important things to do in the Grama sabha" said a child line volunteer.

Counseling for parents

The Child line has summoned the girls and their parents for counseling on 05.01.2017.' It's our collective responsibility to prevent child marriages' said counselor Raju Krishnan. And Karunamoorthi

District child protection officer Mr. Rathakrishnan said measures would be taken to prevent marriages before the girls turned 18

There are 29 child Marriage prevention officers in the Trichy district Purchase educational materials. He gave encouragement saying that they can outperform in schools. She also distributed sweets and clothes to the children. The children under various age groups also got the opportunity to burst crackers with the AWARE SUISSSE auditor. U.Boopathy Executive Director AWARE said the HIV affected school children's should not be discriminated in schools and people should be aware that the disease does not spread by touching or through air. He also added that AWARE will take up measures to provide financial assistance even next year.

Educate child about sexual abuse SEMINAR WORKSHOP for the parents and teachers

Sexual abuse is now becoming a common issue in schools with its rate increasing alarmingly. Society views education Institutions, especially teachers with a lot of respect, and when a student is abused by a teacher, it raises concern. Cithara, mother of a seven-year old girl, says, “It’s important for parents to discuss with their kids how to differentiate between right and wrong touch”.

WHAT IS THE RIGHT AGE?

- Clinical psychologist Dr.Indra says, “The discussion at the age of three should be about right and wrong touch. In my opinion, both the girls and boys should be taught and made aware about sexual abuse. Children at this age do understand various body parts and how nobody should be allowed to touch their private parts.”

KEEP THE DISCUSSION SIMPLE

- Child counselor Manimekalai says, “Parents should explain about abuse from a child’s perspective so that they are well informed and not scared about the whole thing. Teach them about good touch and bad touch early in life so that he/she is aware that some parts of the body are not meant to be touched by anybody”.

TALK ABOUT RULES

- Children can comprehend rules faster than adults. They should be told that even when he or she is going to the toilet in the school, nobody should be allowed to touch his/her private parts. Children should be told that other than the parents if someone touches them, that if anything is making them feel uncomfortable, they should report it to their parents.

HOW TO COMMUNICATE

- Make it a habit to ask your child what has happened in school regularly. Shangamithirai, mother of an eight-year old boy, says, “I make it appoint to discuss everything with my son when he comes back from school. I repeatedly tell him that we are going to be there for him all the time and that he should not hide anything from us, now if anything is bothering him, he discusses it with us.”

KEEP THE TONE CORRECT

- The tone in which you communicate to the child is important. The tone shouldn't be loud. The tone should reflect sensitivity and it should appear to the child that his/her parents are weaving a safety net for them with boundaries, and no one is allowed to enter these boundaries, as far as physical contact is concerned

The AWARE Health clinic center:

The AWARE Mini Health Clinic that have been re opened up has been functioning successfully as daily 20-3040 women, girls, mothers are turning up at the clinic, avail medical consultations for their health needs and ailments. Each patient who require medicines prescribed have been given Rs.50 per head to purchase medicines. 20-30 patients are turning up, register their names for consultations and avail health care and assistance. Now two Health clinic centers functioning one in AWARE Administrative office Morning 10 A.M to 1PM.in rural phase, another one worrier, Nachiyarkovil stop in slums phase. They were peoples more useful with benefited their children's and slums poor people's take care to the clinic centres.

AWARE Health Clinic Is now completing one year on 30th September successfully with the support and guidance of AWARE SUISSE. When it was first launched in in October last year at our AWARE office with one doctor and a nurse the average patients served was around 20 per day.

The working time was 10pm to 1 pm.The clinic primarily served the poor and the needy from the nearby areas under our project. Since the clinic served the people free of cost and also medicines were provided free up to Rs 50, there was growing demand and the people requested that the clinic be shifted to WORiyur where more target population can access and get the benefits and services out of the clinic.

So paying heed to their request the clinic was duly shifted to the present premises. After shifting the clinic is now able to cater to around 26 to 30 persons per day. The working hours now at the clinic are 10 am to 1 pm and 6pm to 9 pm every day. The clinic works through on all days in a week except on Sundays and important holidays. So in a month approximately more than 1000 persons –men, women and children from around our project area from the slums and the peripheries are getting the outpatient free health services of the clinic. They are also getting free medicine up to the tune of Rs 50 per person. The doctor and the nurse are working full time.

Whenever any major or chronic ailment is detected in the patients immediately they are referred to the other hospitals both government and the private. But most of them rarely all of the referred are not able to avail the costs of the private hospitals. Those some who have the medical insurance government issued cards get some relief and the rest are left to suffer without any recourse.

The people are now well aware of the free health service that AWARE is providing them with the support of AWARE-SUISSE. They are very much appreciative and thankful to the health service of AWARE India and are using the clinic in increasing number. Especially during the rainy season when children fall sick frequently and epidemic like dengue and other viral fevers set in the clinic serves them as great blessing.

Menstrual Hygiene and Reproductive Health Programme

This training was on Menstrual Hygiene and Reproductive Health to adolescent girls. They were "free from pain" after shifting to reusable cloth pads. Over 65 young women gathered to discuss how using cloth pads, distributed by AWARE, Trichy working on slums sanitation and hygiene has changed their lives for the better. Mrs Rani, slum coordinator of AWARE said that women would have to walk to a Market at least 1 km away to defecate, bathe, or to change their pads when they menstruate. There have been incidents when men working in the Market have attempted to harass the women, fearing them, the girls would go early in the morning before sunrise or late in the night, she said. MS Jaya, a young girl studying in class 12th said that she suffered from severe rashes and discomfort while using commercially made pads." I was never able to pay attention when the teacher was teaching. We could not even change the pad in school and would wait till we reach home, and then wait till it turned dark, which would be after over eight to ten hours, she said, AWARE combined the promotion of free pads with its menstrual hygiene management training and construction of toilets in the slums. Young children too, are taught the importance of personal hygiene.

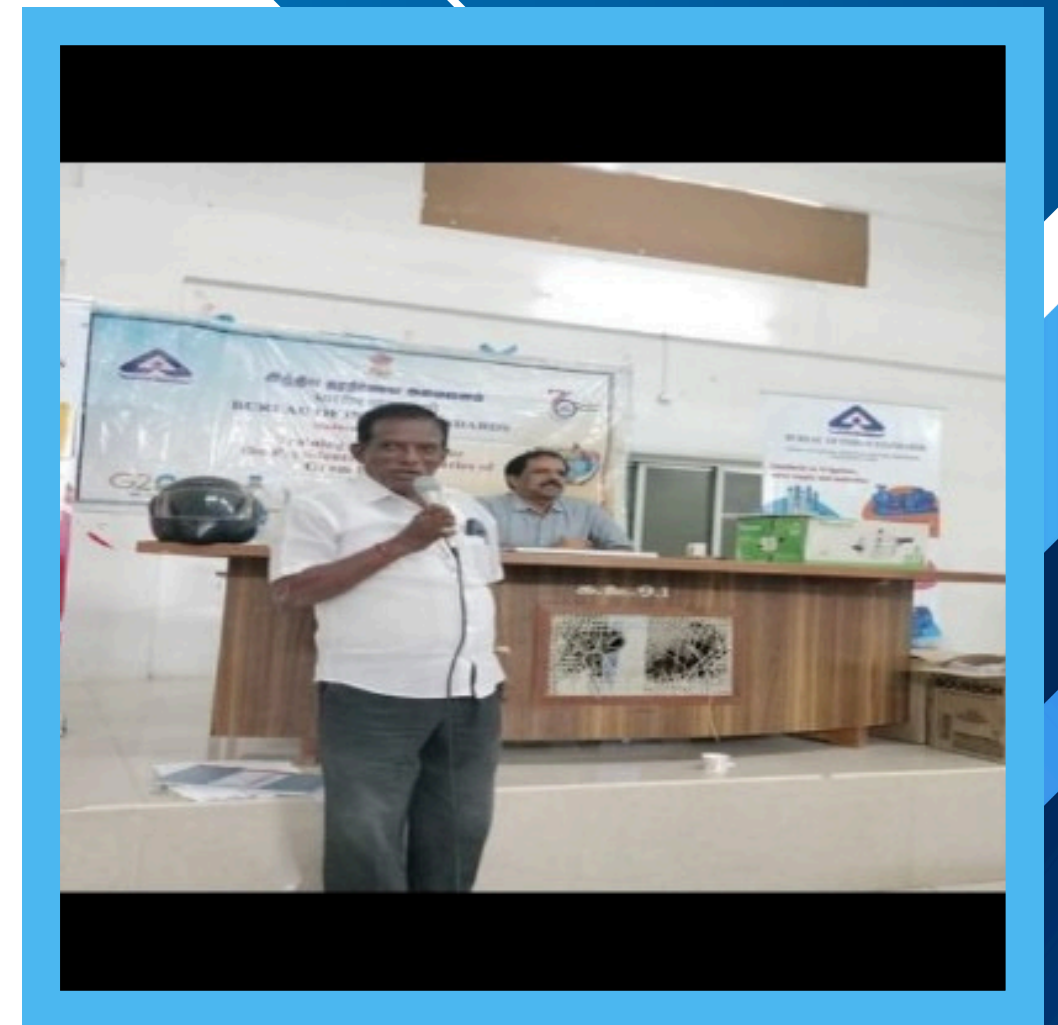
